

ROAD IMPROVEMENT WORKS FOR CORPORATION OF THRISSUR

The work of Road improvement works for Thrissur (TSR-RT-01) was awarded to M/s. G.H. Vijapura & Co. & EKK & Co. at a probable amount of Contract Rs.28,27,47,265/-. The Contract Agreement was signed on 25-03-2008 and the work was started in April 2008.

The construction work was inaugurated by Hon. Minister for LSGD S/s. Paloli Muhammed kutty.



The work envisages Road improvement works such as construction of **foot path, side drains, surfacing using dense Bituminous Macadam and concrete** etc. The work is proposed on the following roads.

Apart from above construction of 3 subways, providing street lights along roads are also envisaged in the contract work.

The following works are completed as on 31 July 2008.

- Chiyaram - Koorkkenchery Road: About 200m of new drain work.
- KSRTC – Fathima Nagar Road:
About 785m new drain constructed and work is in progress.
- Swaraj Round to Mathrubhumi Circle:
About 505m of new drain work completed and cover slab laid. Construction of retaining wall on western side of road embankment is progress.
- About 460m of Dense Bituminous Macadam and Bituminous concrete work completed.



Swaraj Round to Patturaikkal (Shornur Road)

Raising of side drain walls completed about 535m and balance work is in progress. Development of parking area on side of above road completed.



Pedestrian Subways:

Three pedestrian subways are proposed in the Swaraj Round. One at Naikkanal near entrance of Shornur road, second near Paramekkavu temple and third near District Hospital across Palakkad road.

The construction of pedestrian subway at Paramekkavu junction is proposed to be stated after the traditional "Pulikkali" celebrations in Thrissur road i.e. after onam and is expected to be completed before the Thrissur Pooram.
